A recent sermon about salvation got me thinking about Pennysaver newspapers.

Maybe it was tripping over them in my front lawn, late to choir as usual, or, maybe the homily had headed off down a rabbit hole and my mind wandered, but for whatever reason, my thoughts turned to the Pennysavers piling up on my lawn.
