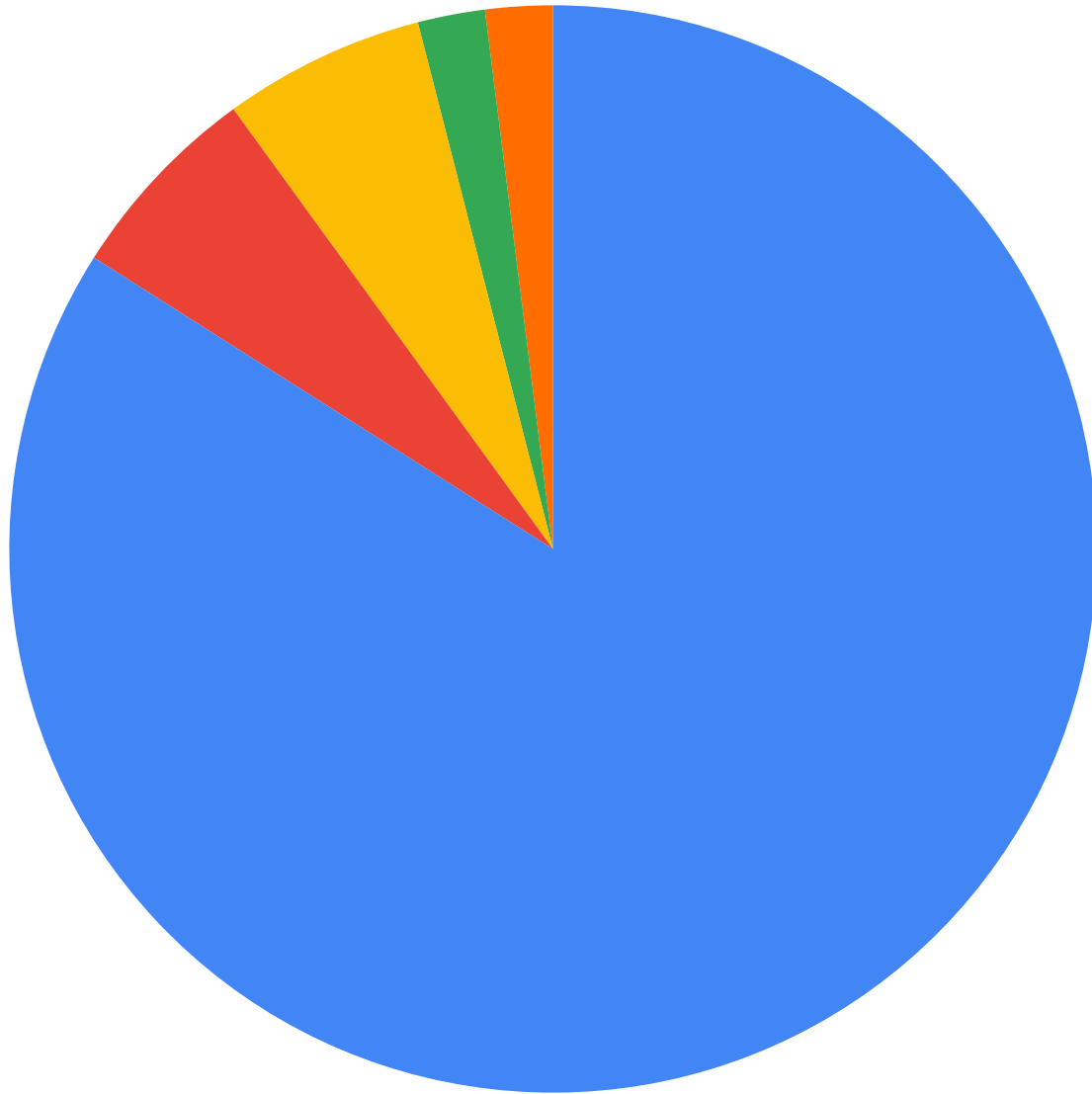
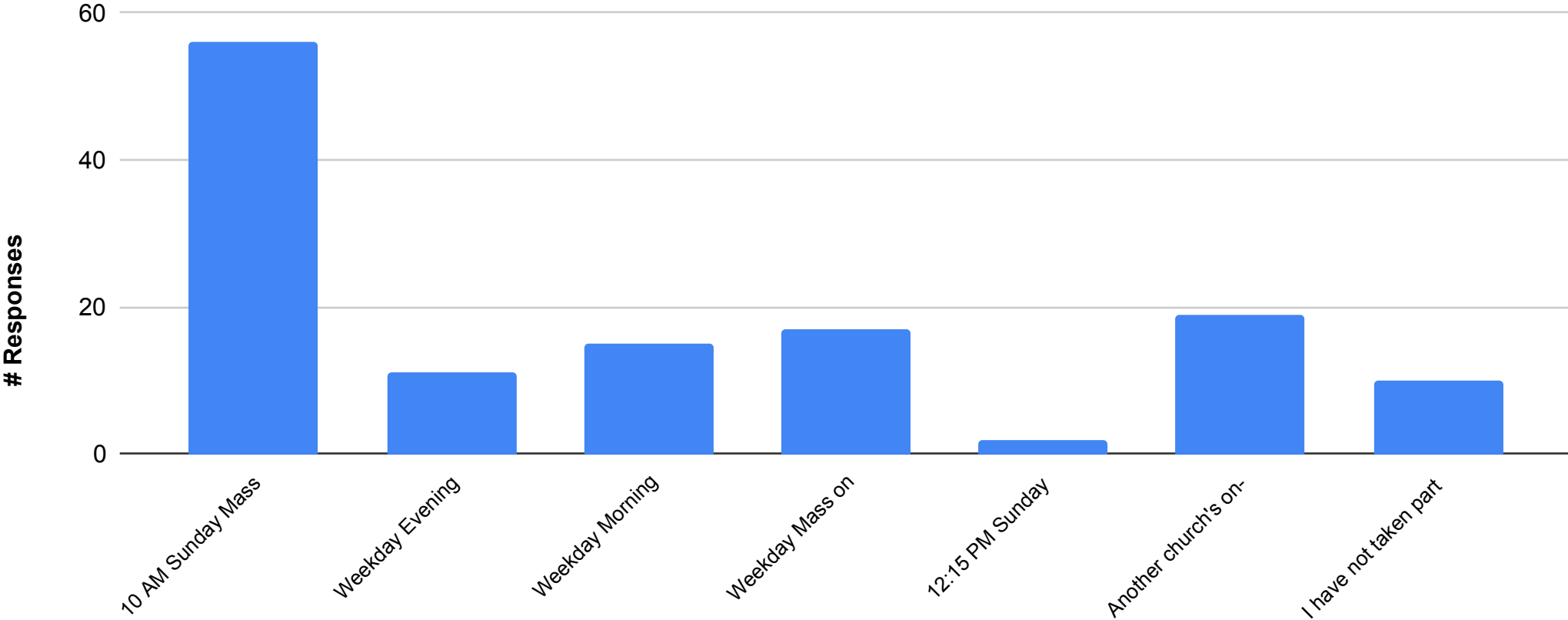


Are there barriers to your participation in on-line worship services?

Services attended during COVID

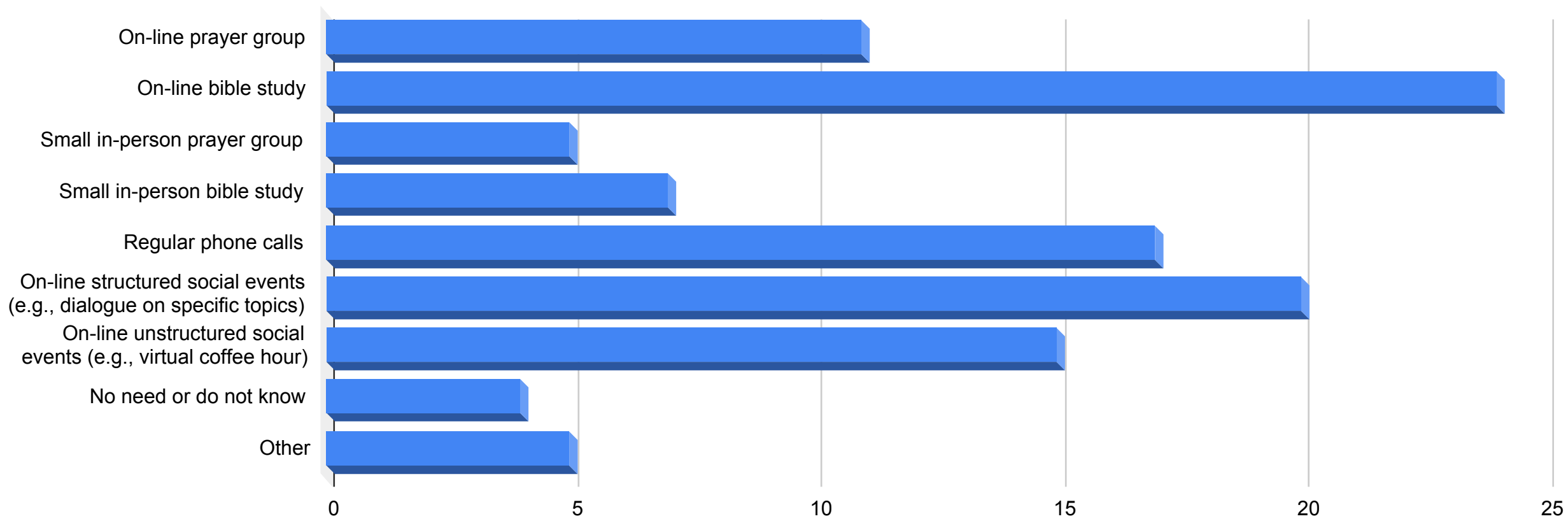

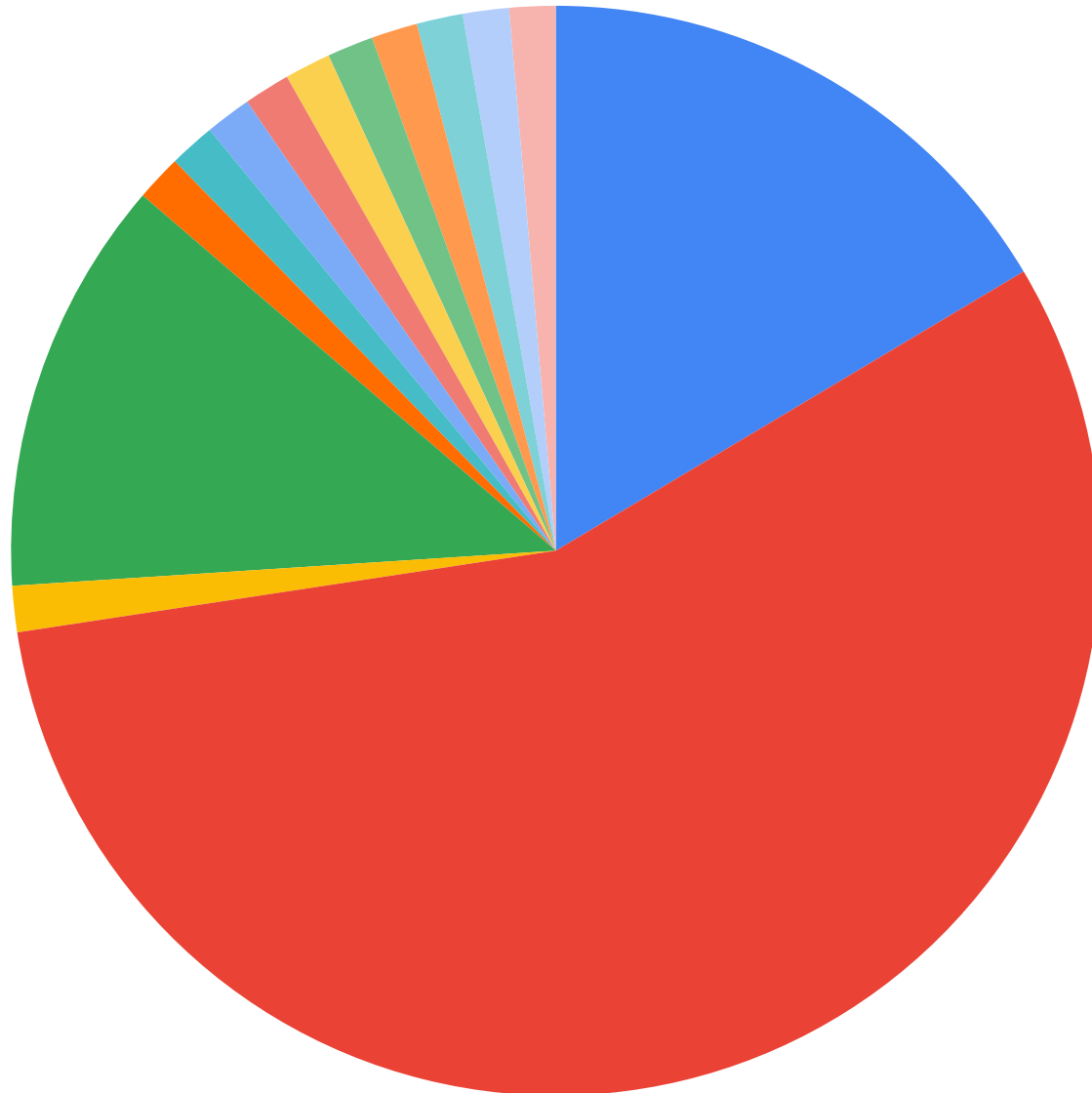

Besides worship services, what other activities should St. Paul's offer to support your spiritual well-being?

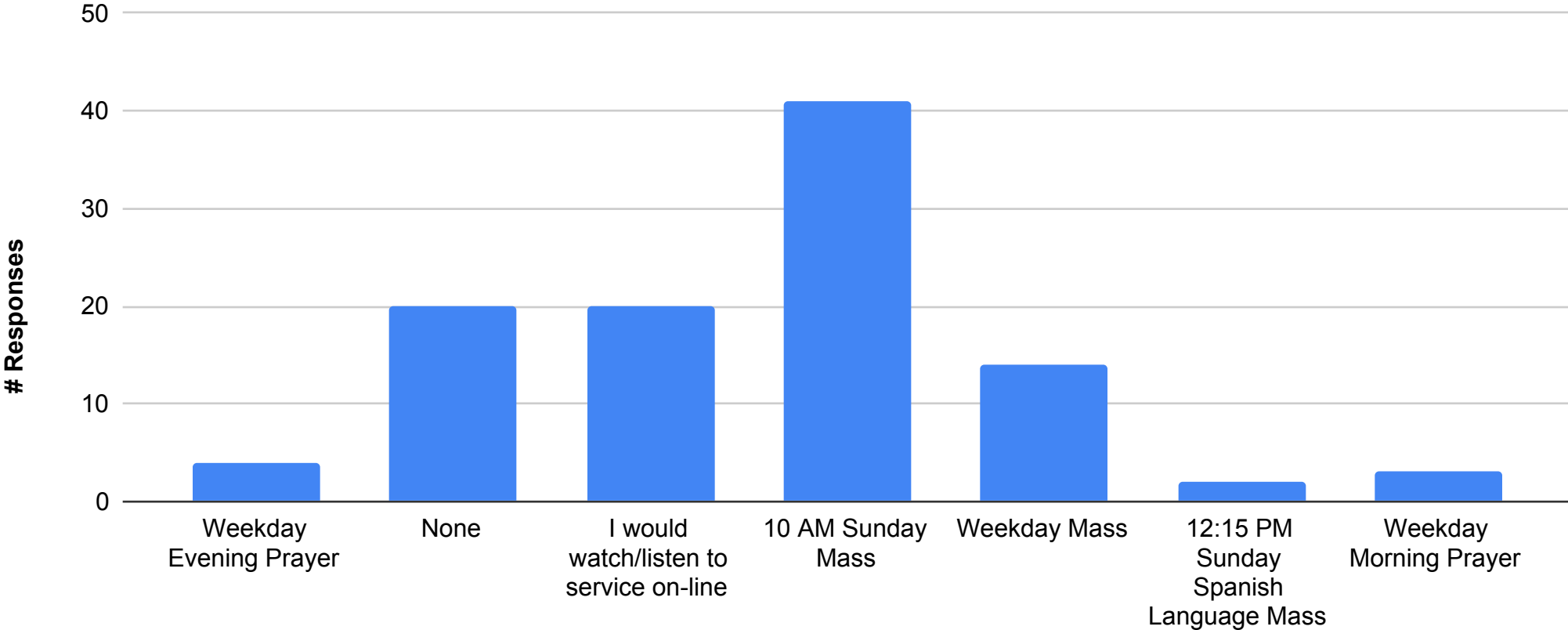


How soon would you be willing to return to in-person worship services at St. Paul's?

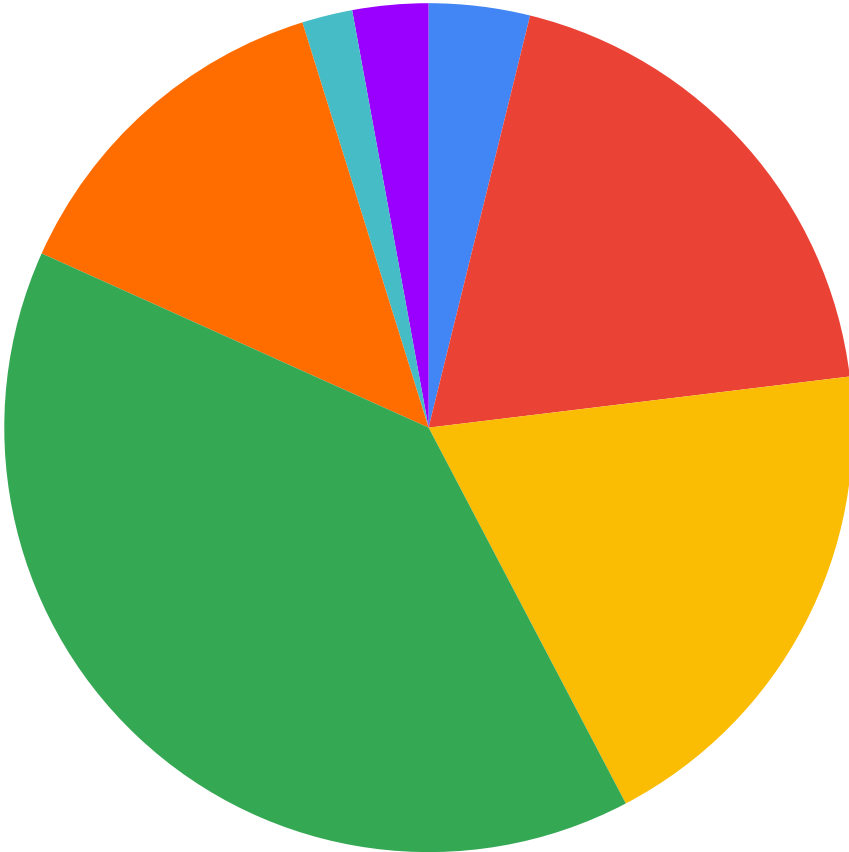


- It depends on how I feel about the safety measures being put in place
